The September 2009 show is the Thunderbirds' second appearance at the popular Northern California event. The California Capital Airshow will also host an impressive array of military and law enforcement aircraft, including the F-22. In addition, aerobatic and specialty performers, vintage and amphibious aircraft, new aircraft displays, and colorful war birds will be featured during the action-packed show.

Big Build Bond Offer Announced

On Wednesday, June 24, 2009, the Sacramento County Airport System announced the offer to issue approximately \$478 million in tax exempt revenue bonds to finance a significant portion of The Big Build Project. Senior Revenue Bonds (Series 2009A and 2009B) and Subordinate PFC/Grant Revenue Bonds (Series 2009C and 2009D) will fund construction of facilities associated with The Big Build. A retail order period is expected to commence on July 15, 2009 with final pricing expected to occur on July 16, 2009. The bond maturities range from 2010 to 2041.

Summer Air Travel Tips

The summer air travel season is upon us and passengers can make their trips easier by following these simple tips.

- The name on your travel documents should match the name on your Driver's License or U.S. Passport.
- A U.S. Passport is required for U.S. citizens flying to Mexico and Canada.
- Put your name and contact information on the inside and outside of your luggage in case it is misplaced.
- Do not attempt to bring fireworks of any kind on an aircraft. They are not allowed.
- Visit the [Transportation Security Administration's Web site](#) for information on other security requirements.
- Check your airline's baggage restrictions before you pack. Each carrier is different; please visit their [Web sites](#) for more information.
- Drive safely and watch for traffic controls due to construction on the [Big Build](#).
- Parking or waiting at the curbs is always prohibited. Do not leave your car unattended at the curb.
- If you are picking up or dropping off loved ones, wait FREE in the Cell Phone Lot for up to three hours. Unattended vehicles are prohibited.
